- (a) the total number of Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) under the Railways and the details of the capital invested by the railways in these undertakings, PSU-wise;**
- (b) whether the Government has conducted any assessment of the utility of Public Sector Undertakings under the Railways and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether the Government is likely to reduce the number of such undertakings to make them profitable; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a) There are 14 Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) under the administrative control of Ministry of Railways. Railways' share of paid-up capital in these PSUs as on 31st March 2015 is as below:-

(b) Yes, Madam. Memorandum of Understanding is signed every year by the Ministry of Railways with the PSUs wherein annual targets are set. Evaluation is done at the end of every financial year and each PSU is graded based on its performance. The Ministry of Railways also reviews their performance periodically.

(c) & (d) No, Madam. There is no proposal for reduction in number of PSUs under the Ministry of Railways.
