Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to print barcode on unreserved tickets and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether the printing of unreserved tickets is likely to be done by thermal printer so that the printed information will disappear itself after five hours;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;**
- (d) whether in case the train is late after buying the ticket, the passenger is likely to be considered without ticket due to disappearance of data from the ticket;**
- (e) if so, the measures taken to tackle such a situation; and**
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**
