- (c) whether any action has been taken by the Government in this regard and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has any timeline to implement these proposals; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): The Cabinet Committee of Economic Affairs(CCEA) while discussing the proposal of Government of Odisha for setting up Information Technology Investment Region(ITIR) in Bhubaneswar, has directed on 10.09.2014 that the Information Technology Investment Region Policy Resolution, 2008 be comprehensively re-examined in the light of the experience gained over time, and placed before the Committee. Based on the suggestions received from the State Governments and Inter Ministerial Consultation, a note for Amendment in ITIR Policy Resolution 2008 has been prepared for consideration of CCEA. The proposal of Government of Andhra Pradesh to set up ITIR at Visakhapatnam will be submitted for approval of CCEA after the consideration/approval of Amendments in ITIR Policy Resolution 2008.
