SKILL TRAINING FOR POOR

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government is making any efforts through imparting skill to make the urban poor eligible for gainful employment or undertake wage employment;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is focusing on SCs/STs in urban areas so that they can become eligible for gainful employment or undertake wage employment;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING & URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION [SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO]

- (a) & (b): The Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Urban Livelihoods Mission". The Employment through Skill Training & Placement (EST&P) component of the Mission aims at providing skill training to urban poor so that they can find gainful employment or set up self-employment ventures or secure wage employment.
- (c) to (e): As per Mission guidelines, SCs and STs are to be benefited at least to the extent of the proportion of their population in the city.
