- (a) whether the Government intends to run Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) powered trains in various parts of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether result of pilot project taken in Ahmedabad for CNG powered trains has been found workable; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) (i) Railways have sanctioned conversion of 100 Nos. of driving power car (DPC) of Diesel Electric Multiple Unit (DEMU) into dual fuel with Compressed Natural Gas (CNG).
 - (ii) Eleven CNG powered DPCs are working at Shakurbasti based DEMU rakes operative on Northern Railway and North Western Railway.
- (c)&(d) No, Madam. Such pilot project has not been taken up in Ahmedabad for CNG powered trains.
