- (a) whether the Government has organised any workshop for the Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS) in textile sector;
- (b) if so, the objectives thereof and the details of industries and institutions who participated in the said workshops
- (c) whether the participation of State Governments in promotion of various schemes targeted for the development of skills in the said sector has been encouraging; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

## ANSWER

### MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

(a) to (d) The Ministry of Textiles has conducted a National Workshop on Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS) on 27th August 2015 in New Delhi. The objective of the workshop was to showcase the achievements of the scheme and obtain feedback from stakeholders to improve implementation of the scheme. List of organizations, who participated in the workshop, is enclosed in **Annexure-A**.

Under ISDS, State government agencies partner with the Ministry to implement the Scheme under Component-III. So far 17 State Governments agencies have come forward with project proposals and a target of training 205,882 persons has been sanctioned to them. Remaining States have been requested to send their proposal under the scheme. A statement indicating state –wise sanction under ISDS is enclosed at **Annexure-B**.
