1174. SHRI DALPAT SINGHPARASTE:

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether his Ministry implements schemes through private agencies/NGO's or sanction projects to them;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the names of NGOs/ VOs/ Organisations/ agencies/ department/ institutions/ foundations/ academies/ National Research Centers / Directorate/ Project Directorates under the administrative control of his Ministry; and
- (c) the details of funds sanctioned to each such organisation during the last three years, yearwise along with the estimated budget for the year 2016-17; and
- (d) whether the Government has received complaints regarding mis-utilization of funds allotted to these organizations, if so, the details thereof, organization-wise and the action taken by the Government against the defaulters?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR POWER, COAL & NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

- (a): Yes Madam. Some of the Schemes/programmes of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) are also implemented through private institutions/Non-governmental Organizations (NGOs).
- (b)&(c): A list of private institutions/NGOs along with the funds released to them by the MNRE during the last three years i.e. 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 (up to 31.1.2016) are given in the Statement enclosed as Annexure. The budgeted funds are allocated during a year (including for the year 2016-17) under the Schemes/ Programmes of the Ministry. Funds to, inter-alia, private institutions are sanctioned on project to project basis received during that year.
- (d): The MNRE has not received any complaint so far regarding the mis-utilization of funds released to the organizations listed in the Annexure.
