(a): Weavers Service Centres (WSCs) are the technical wings of Office of Development Commissioner for Handlooms, Ministry of Textiles which render technical assistance to the handloom industry by way of research, service & training for its development. Presently, 28 WSCs are functioning from across the country and these are playing a vital role in imparting training to the weavers of the country to upgrade their skill and increase productivity in the handloom sector. These are the instrumental in evolving innumerable new design & reviving traditional designs.

(b) to (d): In pursuance of budget speech 2012-13, three new WSCs one each in the states of Jharkhand, Nagaland and Mizoram, have been set up during 12th Plan. Since a WSC is already functioning from Ahmedabad (Gujarat), setting up of WSC at Surat, Rajkot is not under the consideration of Government.
