1. PradhanMantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY)

The World Bank is assisting construction and upgradation of road works under Rural Roads Projects-I (RRP-I) and Rural Roads Projects-II (RRP-II) The Gross Budgetary Support (GBS) for PMGSY programme includes assistance under External Aided Projects by World Bank and Asian Development Bank (ADB). This Ministry has received assistance of US\$ 399.5 million for years 2005-2012 under the World Bank supported Rural Roads Projects-I (RRP-I). Further, an assistance of US\$ 1400 million has been approved under ongoing Rural Roads Projects-II (RRP-II) for a 5 year period (2011-2015). The scheduled completion of RRP-II is in November, 2015.

The details of loan taken for the States namely; Assam, Chhatisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and West Bengal under ADB and in 8 participating States namely Bihar, Jharkhand, Himachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh under World Bank and the utilization thereof may be seen in Annexure-I(a)&(b) and Annexure-II.

(2)National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM)

(i) The Government is implementing National Rural Livelihoods Mission, renamed as DeendayalAntyodayaYojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY - NRLM) across the country in a mission mode with the objective of organizing the rural poor women into Self Help Groups (SHGs), and continuously nurturing and supporting them till they attain appreciable increase in incomes over a period of time and improve their quality of life and come out of abject poverty. It aims to cover all the States and Union Territories (except Delhi and Chandigarh) and seeks to reach out to all rural poor women in a phased manner by the year 2024-25. A World Bank aided National Rural Livelihoods Project (NRLP) is being implemented under the aegis of NRLM. The Government of India has signed an agreement with the World Bank in July, 2011, for availing IDA credit of US \$ 1 billion (approximately Rs. 4500 crore) for National Rural Livelihoods Project (NRLP) to be availed over a period of five years. The objective was to increase effectiveness of the resources being utilized under NRLM through professionalizing the overall program management and moving towards a results-based approach throughout the country. Subsequently, the project has been restructured and the credit amount reduced to US \$500 million which is to be availed by December 2017. NRLP is being implemented in select blocks of 13 high poverty States which account for 92% of the rural poor in the country. These States are Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal. It is a demand based programme and the funds are released to the States keeping in view the amount approved under their Annual Action Plan and the extent of funds available. A statement indicating the funds sanctioned, released and expenditure incurred under NRLP is enclosed as Annexure I.

(ii):- Governance Accelerated and Livelihoods Security (GOALS) project:-The Government has signed an agreement with the United National Development Programme for implementation of GOALS project. The project aims at improving implementation of National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) and Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) by strengthening local participation by converging efforts. The project covers 12 Left Wing Extremism (LWE)districts in 3 States namely, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha, with a total outlay of Rs.128.98 crores.So far, the funds as indicated below have been released to UNDP underDevelopment Support Services (DSS) component during 2014-15 and 2015-16 :-

DeenDayalUpadhyayGrameenKaushalYojana (DDU-GKY) is a placement linked Skill Development Programme for Rural Poor Youth under National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM), a component of (i.e NRL project). NRLM is funded by World Bank.

NRLP has been signed between Govt. of India and World Bank and is valid till Dec., 2017. NRLP Project is being implemented in the country under NRLM.
