- (a) whether all the selected Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) gram panchayats have prepared and finalized their Village Development Plans (VDPs) as planned;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether all these gram panchayats have conducted base line survey;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/ UT-wise;
- (e) whether the Government proposes to change its strategy based on the experiences of implementation of SAGY in first phase; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): The State/UT-wise details of the selected Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) gram panchayats who have prepared and finalized their Village Development Plans (VDPs) and also those gram panchayats who have conducted base line survey, as posted by the concerned district nodal officers on the Ministry's website of SAGY, are at Annexure I.

(e) to (f): As the change in the strategy based on the experiences of implementation is the inherent requirement of every Scheme, this will be done under SAGY as well, after analyzing the results of the activities for development of the first set of Adarsh Grams, which are going on as per the Village Development Plans.
