### SHIFTING OF DOMESTIC SERVICES OF MUMBAI AIRPORT

(a) whether the domestic services have not yet been shifted to new buildings of Mumbai airport?

(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons thereof?

(c) the details about the original timeframe of shifting of domestic services to new buildings?

(d) the time by which domestic services of Mumbai airport are likely to be shifted to new buildings?

#### ANSWER

(a) to (d): M/s Mumbai International Airport Private Limited (MIAL) had planned to shift the entire domestic traffic of Mumbai airport to the new building subsequent to commissioning of international services from T 2 and completion of apron and other facilities after demolition of old building and hangars of Air India. However, there was a delay in handing over of hangars for demolition, which resulted in delay in shifting of domestic traffic to new building. Consequent upon the commencement of international operations and other infrastructure works, MIAL commenced shifting of domestic operations to new Terminal T2 building in a phased manner. Accordingly, domestic operations of Air India and Vistara have commenced from the new building. Operations of Jet Airways are scheduled to be commenced w.e.f. 15.03.2016 and Indigo after 15.03.2016.
