In order to focus on Northern border as per the operational requirement of Army, Border Roads Organisation (BRO) has handed over stretches of different roads of length measuring 252.96 km to National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) and length measuring 1541.97 km to State Public Works Department (PWD).
