AVAILABILITY OF AYUSH MEDICINE

1441. SHRI PARBHUBHAI NAGARBHAI VASAVA:

Will the Minister of **AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH)** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all the systems of medicine of AYUSH are available in all the Government hospitals and dispensaries in the country including Gujarat and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has prepared any scheme for providing AYUSH treatment facility in the hospitals and dispensaries; and
- (c) if so, the time limit fixed in this regard along with the details of Government hospitals having AYUSH facility?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Public Health being a State subject, the primary responsibility to ensure the availability of all systems of medicine of AYUSH in Government hospitals lies with the respective State/UT Governments. However, under the National Health Mission (NHM), technical and financial support is provided to States/UTs for strengthening their healthcare systems, including for mainstreaming of AYUSH through co-located facilities, based on the requirements posed by the States/UTs in their Programme Implementations (PIPs). Status of AYUSH Facilities Co-located at Various Healthcare facilities State/UT-wise including Gujarat is furnished at **Annexure-I**.

Further, the Central Government has launched National AYUSH Mission (NAM) during 12th Plan for implementing through States/UTs. The basic objective of NAM is to promote AYUSH systems of medicine through cost effective AYUSH services for providing AYUSH treatment facility in the hospitals and dispensaries, strengthening of educational systems, facilitate the enforcement of quality control of Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani & Homoeopathy (ASU &H) drugs and sustainable availability of raw-materials for ASU & H medicines. As per the information reported by the State/UT Governments, the number of AYUSH hospitals and dispensaries available in the country State/UT-wise including Gujarat is furnished at **Annexure-II**.
