- the number of complaints received by the Central Board of Direct Taxes during the last three years on the issue of problems being faced in filing Income Tax returns;
- whether a new digital signature software has been developed to reduce the number of complaints;
- if so, the time by which this software is likely to become operational; and
- if not, the intention of the Government in this regard and the details thereof?

- The number of complaints received by the Central Board of Direct Taxes during the last three years regarding problems in filing Income Tax returns electronically are as under:

Financial Year	Complaints related to uploading of returns requiring Non-Digital Signature	Complaints related to uploading of returns requiring Digital Signature and other General Queries
2013-14	20,792	8,669
2014-15	10,969	8,631
2015-16 (upto 29.02.2016)	17,013	7,023

- Yes, a new digital signature software utility was prepared and implemented from 21st January, 2016 to resolve the problems reported by taxpayers in uploading income tax return with digital signature.
- The new software utility is already operational from 21st January, 2016.
