

- (a) the growth rate of GDP over the last three years according to the new series;
- (b) whether the growth rate of GDP has fallen or risen over the last one and a half year i.e. 2014-15 and 2015-16;
- (c) the average growth rate of GDP for the last three years 2014-16; and
- (d) whether there is a mechanism to assess the impact of the changed GDP series on the final growth numbers?

(a): The growth rate of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at constant (2011-12) market prices during the last three years is given in the following table.

(b): As per the quarterly estimates of national income, the estimates of GDP are available up to third quarter of 2015-16. The growth rate of GDP at constant market prices during first three quarters (April – December) of 2015-16 works out to 7.5 per cent, as compared to the corresponding period's growth of 7.4 per cent in 2014-15. As per the Advance Estimates of National Income, the GDP growth for 2015-16 is estimated to be 7.6 per cent, as compared to the growth of 7.2 per cent in 2014-15.

(c): The average growth rate of GDP at constant market prices from 2013-14 to 2015-16 was 7.2 per cent.

(d): The Central Statistics Office brings out the annual estimates of GDP for a financial year first as Advance Estimates during early February, about two months before the end of the year. With additional information becoming available, the advance estimates are subsequently revised. The final growth numbers reflect such revisions. Changes in methodology and coverage from old to new series have also resulted in the changes in growth rates. GDP growth rates as per the old series and new series are given below:
