UTILIZATION OF FUNDS BY MAULANA AZAD EDUCATION FOUNDATION

163: SHRI BADRUDDIN AJMAL:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is true that out of total funds allocated to the Maulana Azad Education Foundation (MAEF), only few percent amount has been released during the last few years;
- (b) if so, the details of the funds allocated to MAEF during the last three years along with the details of funds utilised ; and
- (c) the projects/schemes being implemented by the foundation?

- (a) and (b) No, Madam. The Ministry of Minority Affairs has released the entire earmarked funds to contribute to the Corpus fund of Maulana Azad Education Foundation (MAEF) during last two years and the current financial year. Further, the MAEF earns interest by investing the Corpus fund, which is its only source of income. This interest amount is utilized for implementation of schemes by MAEF. The details of funds allocated in favour of MAEF, the amount released by the Ministry as contribution to Corpus fund and the amount utilized by MAEF out of the interest earned in last two years and the current year are as follows:

- (c) The MAEF implements two schemes for minorities which are as follows:
- (i) Maulana Azad National Scholarships to Meritorious Girls belonging to Minority communities;
 - (ii) Grant-in-Aid to Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) for development of educational infrastructure.
