## Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Delhi Milk Scheme (DMS) is running into losses and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) the details of the profit/loss of DMS during each of the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to lease out Delhi Milk Scheme to a cooperative or a semi-Government agency in near future; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken by the Government to make the DMS profitable?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE & FARMERS WELFARE (SHRI MOHANBHAI KUNDARIYA)

- (a) Delhi Milk Scheme(DMS) has accumulated losses of Rs.842.57 crore since its inception upto 31st March 2015. The reason for losses may be primarily attributed to its under utilisation of plant capacity.
- (b) The details of profit/loss position of DMS during each of the last three years are indicated below:

YEARS	NET LOSS/ PROFIT (In crores)
2012-13	(+)5.32
2013-14	(-)15.88
2014-15	(+)6.65

(c) & (d) Yes, Madam, The Government has decided to hand over operations and management of DMS to a Suitable O & M agency on lease basis for 30 years.
