DOG SQUAD FOR NDRF

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is true that a squad of 162 dogs is being raised by the National Disaster Response Force to aid its personnel in rescuing people trapped under debris in the aftermath of natural calamities; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): The National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) has a authorized strength of 168 dogs in different battalions to aid its personnel in rescuing the people trapped under debris in the aftermath of natural calamities. At present, the number of dogs available in different squads is 148, out of which 83 are trained dogs and training is being imparted to the remaining 65 dogs.
