The National Backward Classes Finance and Development Corporation (NBCFDC), under the aegis of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, is already implementing a scheme for professionally educated youth to start their self-employment ventures with loans of uptoRs. 10 Lakh from NBCFDC. The Loan is available through their State Channelising Agencies (SCAs). The name of the scheme is "SAKSHAM". The details of the scheme "SAKSHAM" is annexed.
