Composite Regional Centres

1815. SHRI BAHADUR SINGH KOLI:

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal from various State Governments for setting up of Composite Regional Centres for differently abled persons in their respective States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Rajasthan; and
- (c) the present Status such proposals alongwith the time by which they are likely to be cleared?

(a) to (c) The Government has received proposals for setting up of Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) from State Governments of Chhattisgarh, Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Tripura, Manipur, Odisha, Rajasthan, Karnataka, Sikkim, Jammu & Kashmir and Maharashtra.

Government has approved CRC at Rajnandgaon in Chhattisgarh and CRC at Nellore in Andhra Pradesh. Government is also setting up CRCs' at Jaipur in (Rajasthan), Devangere (Karnataka), South Sikkim (Sikkim) and Nagpur (Maharashtra).
