(a) : No such cases have been reported in any of the operational metro rail projects. However, during peak hours, long queues at security checks are observed at few terminals or interchange stations of Delhi Metro only.

(b)to(d): Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) has informed that they have provided additional Door Frame Metal Detector (DFMD) at 50 stations.
