SOCIAL AUDIT SCHEME

No.1858. SHRI BHOLA SINGH:

Will the Minister OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government proposes to launch Social Audit scheme in local bodies like Municipality;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether many schemes like AMRUT, Housing for All and Smart Cities Mission have been launched for urban development;
- (d) if so, the reasons for failure of previous schemes; and
- (e) the details of challenges being faced by the Government to make cities smart?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a)& (b): No, Madam. There is no proposal to launch Social Audit Scheme in Local Bodies. However, various schemes guidelines provide for instructions regarding social audit through creditable institutions and citizen participation.

- (c): Yes, Madam. The schemes like Smart Cities, AMRUT, Swachh Bharat Mission and Housing for All etc., have been launched by Government.
- (d): Previous schemes like JNNURM have come to an end. Lessons for better implementation from those schemes have been incorporated in the new schemes guidelines.
- (e): The Government is striving to address the challenges of capacity, finance, convergence, adoption of latest technology and involvement of stakeholders in the effort to make cities smart.
