- (a) the details of mining sites under the control of the Indian Rare Earth Ltd. (IREL) State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of the rare earths mined from the mines, mining centre-wise along with the quantum of production of the minerals; and
- (c) the total funds allocated by the Government for exploration of rare earth metals during the last three years and the current year?

ANSWER

- (a) The details of mining sites under the control of Indian Rare Earths Limited (IREL), a Public Sector Undertaking under the Department of Atomic Energy are given below:
 - i) Orissa Sands Complex (OSCOM) Mine in Odisha State
 - ii) Chavara Mine, NK Block II EE Ilmenite Mine, Azheekal Ilmenite Mine and NK Block IV EE Ilmenite Mine in Kerala State
 - iii) Manavalakurichi Mine, Midlam & Keezh Midalam Mine and Manavalakurichi, Laxmipuram & Colachel Mine in Tamil Nadu
- (b) Rare earths are extracted in India from a prescribed mineral namely "Monazite" which is one of the mineral among the suit of seven Beach Sand Minerals (BSM).
