Will the Minister of Communications & Information Technology be pleased to state: -

- (a) the objectives behind setting up of Software Technology Park of India (STP);
- (b) the details of Software Technology Park of India which have been registered and currently functioning State-wise;
- (c) whether there are plans to set up more such units in the rural and backward areas of the country; and
- (d) if so, the details of new STPs planned, State/UT-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a): The objectives of the Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) are as under:

- (i) To promote the development and export of software and software services including ITeS/ Bio- IT.
- (ii) To provide statutory and other promotional services to the exporters by implementing Software Technology Park (STP)/ Electronics Hardware Technology Park (EHTP) schemes and such other schemes which may be formulated and entrusted by the Government from time to time.
- (iii) To provide data communication services including value added services to IT / ITeS related industries.
- (iv) To promote micro, small and medium entrepreneurs by creating conducive environment for entrepreneurship in the field of IT/ITeS.

(b) to (d): A total of 54 STPI centres are currently functioning across the country as per the list (State/UT wise) at Annexure-A. STPI is in the process of setting up 24 more STPI centres in smaller cities/towns. The State-wise list of these proposed STPI centres is at Annexure-B.
