NUCLEAR AGREEMENTS

1977. SHRI RAYAPATI SAMBASIVA RAO: SHRI P. KUMAR:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of countries with which India has signed Civil Nuclear Agreements till date;
- (b) whether many of these deals have become fully operational;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the current status of the Indo-US civil nuclear deal?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (Dr) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

(a) to (c) India has signed civil nuclear cooperation agreements with France, United States (US), Russia, Namibia, Canada, Argentina, Kazakhstan, Republic of Korea, Czech Republic, Australia, Sri Lanka and the United Kingdom; a Memorandum of Understanding on civil nuclear cooperation has been signed with Mongolia.

(d) NPCIL & relevant US companies are engaged with regard to the construction of nuclear power reactors at Mithi Virdi (Gujarat) and Kovvada (Andhra Pradesh).
