NUCLEAR AGREEMENTS

- (a) the number of countries with which India has signed Civil Nuclear Agreements till date;**
- (b) whether many of these deals have become fully operational;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (d) the current status of the Indo-US civil nuclear deal?**

ANSWER

(a) to (c) India has signed civil nuclear cooperation agreements with France, United States (US), Russia, Namibia, Canada, Argentina, Kazakhstan, Republic of Korea, Czech Republic, Australia, Sri Lanka and the United Kingdom; a Memorandum of Understanding on civil nuclear cooperation has been signed with Mongolia.

(d) NPCIL & relevant US companies are engaged with regard to the construction of nuclear power reactors at Mithi Viridi (Gujarat) and Kovvada (Andhra Pradesh).
