- (a) the number of railway crossings located on national highways in Jharkhand district-wise and the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has prepared any proposal for construction of overbridges and underbridges at these railway crossings;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the number of surveys conducted in this regard during the last three years, year-wise;
- (e) the outcome of the said surveys; and
- (f) the details of sanctioned projects?

- (a): There are 14 level crossings on National Highways in the State of Jharkhand as on 01.04.2015.
- (b) to (f): As per Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between Ministry of Railways and Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MORTH) on 10.11.2014, MORTH/National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) will replace all level crossings on NH Corridors by Road Over Bridges (ROBs)/Road Under Bridges (RUBs) in next five years subject to availability of funds.
