- (a) Yes Madam. The Government has decided to set up a new major port at Sagar Island in West Bengal.
- (b) The rail-cum-road connectivity with river crossing of Muriganga has been entrusted to National Highway Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd.(NHIDCL). Notice Inviting Tender(NIT) has been issued for engaging a firm for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) with identification of best technological option for river crossing including detailed cost estimate etc. Rail-road alignment involving 86.398 hectares of land acquisition has already been finalized. M/s. Envirotech East Pvt. Ltd. Engaged for environmental clearance.
