- (b) the quantum of river water converted into drinking water and the names of the States getting its benefits, river-wise?

- (a) State Governments / Union Territories take necessary measures for providing drinking water from different sources, including river water, by using various technologies /processes like pre-chlorination, aeration, coagulation, sedimentation, filtration, disinfection etc.
- (b) Details of quantum of river water converted into drinking water by the States are not maintained by the Central Government.
