CSR CONTRIBUTIONS FOR NAMAMI GANGE PROGRAMME

2172. DR. SANJAY JAISWAL

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) contributions towards the Namami Gange Programme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the funds received; and
- (c) the manner in which the Government plans to encourage citizen support for the success of the programme?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Yes, Madam. As part of the Namami Gange program, Government of India has set up "Clean Ganga Fund" for encouraging contributions from Resident Indians, Non-Resident Indians, Persons of Indian Origin, Institutions, and Corporates towards Ganga Rejuvenation. Since contribution to the Clean Ganga Fund has been notified as a Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity, many public sector and private sector companies have contributed to the fund. The Total contribution received till date in Clean Ganga Fund is Rs. 87.69 Crores, which includes contributions amounting to Rs. 78.83 Cores from the Corporates.

The details of contribution by the Corporates are annexed.

(c) The various other efforts of the Government to encourage citizen support for the Namami Gange Programme, in addition to establishing Clean Ganga Fund, are:

- i. Holding regular national level consultations with public participation for cleaning river Ganga. 'Swachh Ganga-Gramin Sahbhagita', a national level stakeholder consultation and sensitization programme was organized on 30th Jan., 2016 at Talkatora, New Delhi. Gram Pradhans of more than 1000 Gram Panchayats located along the river Ganga, eminent policy makers, implementers and NGOs attended the programme. Another programme 'Ganga Manthan' was organized in July, 2014 at New Delhi with various stakeholders including policy makers and implementers, academicians, environmentalists, spiritual leaders and NGOs. It was aimed to provide a platform for various

stakeholders to come together to discuss the issues and possible solutions to the challenging task of Ganga Rejuvenation.

ii. A one-day dialogue on Industrial Pollution was conducted in October 2014, which facilitated a specific consultation with Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs) located in five states along the main stem of Ganga river. Members from industrial associations, senior government officials, and Hon'ble Ministers from key ministries involved in Ganga rejuvenation attended the consultation. In addition, the Government has also involved the local public residing along the river banks, students from school, colleges and all people in the operation clean Ganga.

iii. An amount of Rs. 528 crore has been earmarked for Public Participation under Communication and Public Outreach activities (including raising of Ganga Task Force) for 5 years(2015-2020) under the cabinet approved Namami Gange Programme.

iv. A project for Educating Schools and Communities for conserving habitat of Ganga River Dolphin (100% central share) is being implemented with a budget of Rs. 1.28 Crore.

v. Also, the State Project Monitoring Groups (SPMGs) have been advised to involve the locals of the area in execution and monitoring of the projects undertaken by them.

The views expressed by the stakeholders are useful for the preparation of a road map for a comprehensive plan to rejuvenate the River Ganga. The Government plans to hold several such meetings to make the Clean Ganga Program a people's initiative.
