- (d) the manner in which the technological set up is being upgraded to support the idea of increased production in the country?

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Government is taking key initiatives to promote Man-made Fibre (MMF) in India as under:-

- (i) With effect from 29.10.2015, Merchandise Export from India Scheme (MEIS) has been extended to MMF fibre and yarn for all countries.
- (ii) Interest equalization scheme has been restored on pre and post shipment of rupee export credit of 3% for five year w.e.f. 1st April, 2015.
- (iii) Increased duty drawback rates as well as value cap of MMF textiles.

(c): Reliance and Grasim have increased their production capacities of Polyester and Viscose fibres respectively in 2015.

(d): MMF produced in India are by using world class technology at par with other countries.
