(a): The Government of India has implemented various schemes such as Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (TUFS), Scheme for Development of Technical textiles, Schemes for the Development of the Handloom, Handicraft and Powerloom Sectors, Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks (SITP), Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS), Technology Mission on Technical textiles (TMTT), Schemes for promoting the usage of Agrotexiles and Geotexiles etc, North Eastern Region Textile Promotion Scheme (NERTPS) for development, modernization and expansion of textile industry. These schemes are being implemented on pan India basis based on each States requirement.

(b): The sector-wise details of funds allocated and utilized for 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 is placed at Annexure I.

(c): The allocations made for Powerloom and Handloom Sector in the Budget are placed at Annexure-I.

(e): The measures undertaken by the Government to promote textile industry in the country are listed at (a) above. As far as Uttar Pradesh is concerned, the Ministry of Textiles has provided assistance for 3 parks under Scheme for Integrated Textile Park (SITP), namely, Eco Tex Textile & Apparel Park. Lakshmi Textile Park Fatehpur & Farrukhabad Textile Park. Further, under Integrated Scheme Development Scheme, 45,773 persons have been trained in UP.
