### 2331. SHRI GANESH SINGH:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether sufficient facilities are available for Fine Needle Aspiration Cytology test (FNAC) undertaken in Department of Microbiology in Central Hospitals is not done on Saturdays;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the steps taken by the Government to make full facilities available to patients even on Saturday in the said hospital?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

(a) to (c): In so far as the three Central Government Hospitals in Delhi viz. Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital and Lady Hardinge Medical College & Associated Hospitals are concerned, sufficient facilities for Fine Needle Aspiration Cytology test (FNAC) are available and this test is undertaken in these Hospitals on the weekdays including Saturdays.
