- (a) whether the scheme of National Savings Certificate (NSC) with maturity period of 10 years has been discontinued in post offices;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether any other savings scheme is being launched in place of said scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a), (b), (c) &(d): Yes Madam, Kisan Vikas Patra Scheme was re-launched on 23.9.2014. The maturity period of Kisan Vikas Patras (KVPs) is 100 months. It was felt that KVP and 10 year NSC were more or less in the same maturity basket. It was accordingly decided to discontinue 10 year NSC and keep only Kisan Vikas Patra.
