Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received complaints about declining quality of food being served to the patients in the Government hospitals including AIIMS; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government thereon?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

(a) & (b) Health is a State subject and no such information is maintained Centrally. In so far as AIIMS, New Delhi and three Central Government Hospitals in Delhi i.e. Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital and Lady Hardinge Medical College & Associated Hospitals are concerned, no such complaint has been reported.
