(a) to (c): There have been deficiencies against the authorized quantities of certain specialized parachutes namely Combat Free Fall & Heavy Drop Systems. However, Indents have been placed on Ordnance Factory Board for supply of these parachutes. Some order has also been placed for supply from trade.
