- (d) the amount of seed money sanctioned for this purpose along with the time by which the warship is likely to join the fleet of Navy?

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Joint Working Group's concluding session was held in New Delhi on 18th February 2016. The purpose of the JWGACTC is to provide a forum for exchange of unclassified information regarding aircraft carriers and allows JWGACTC to facilitate identification of mutually beneficial research, development, test or evaluation activities in support of aircraft carrier technology solutions.

(c) Indian Navy has not sought such assistance from the US side.

(d) The proposal for construction of the next Indigenous Aircraft Carrier is at preliminary stage and Rs.2 Crore have been sanctioned for conducting feasibility studies.
