'NO SELFIE ZONES' AT TOURIST SITES

2552. SHRI RAJENDRA AGRAWAL:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that there are several incidents/injuries/deaths occurred at the tourist places during taking selfies/capturing photographs;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is planning to declare/identify 'No Selfie Zones' at the tourist sites; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a) & (b): No, Madam. The Ministry of Tourism has not received any official complaint or report regarding incident of injuries/deaths that occurred at tourist places during taking selfies/capturing photographs.
- (c) & (d): Provision of Safety to tourists for various activities of tourism including safety-precautionary measures to prevent any un-toward incident including declaring of 'No Selfie Zones' at tourist sites are the primary responsibilities of concerned State Governments/UT Administrations.
