FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BY FRANCE TO DEVELOP HERITAGE SITES

2561. SHRI HARISH MEENA:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether France has expressed interest in developing heritage sites and tourism spots for the smart cities;
- (b) if so, the names of those States, including Rajasthan
- (c) whether France has committed investing over 2 billion euros for the scheme ; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a)to(d) No financial assistance by France to develop heritage in smart cities has been proposed. However, recently French Agency for development (AFD) has executed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with States/UTs of Chandigarh, Puducherry and Maharashtra for development of Chandigarh, Oulgaret and Nagpur Municipal Corporations respectively under Smart cities Mission.
- As per information from Ministry of Tourism(MoT), MoT has signed a Letter of Intent (LoI) with France on increasing cooperation in the tourism sector and to encourage promotion of tourism between the two countries.
