**NGOs under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan**

†2593. SHRI JASVANTSINH SUMANBHAI BHABHOR:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is providing any assistance to Non Governmental Organisations (NGOs) under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during the last three years, State/UT-wise and year-wise;
- (c) the provisions made by the Government to monitor functioning of the NGOs; and
- (d) the incidents of violation of the provisions by the NGOs during the last three years, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) programme, there is provision for sanction of assistance to Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs). The details of financial assistance provided to various NGOs during the last three years and the current year are at Annexure.

(c): In order to monitor such NGOs, on the completion of one year, a Joint Evaluation Team consisting of a member of the National level Grant-in-aid Committee, a representative of the State Project Office and a representative of the Ministry of Human Resource Development visit the project and further funds are released on the basis of the evaluation report. Apart from this, the NGO has to submit annual audited accounts, duly certified by a Chartered Accountant.

(d): With regard to funds released to NGOs at Annexure, complaints against M/s Katha, New Delhi in 2012 and M/s Sabrang Trust, Mumbai (Maharashtra) in 2014 were received.
