**Regulation of Coaching Centres**

- (a) whether the Government has taken a note of the mushrooming of various types of coaching and tuition centres in the cities and towns of the country;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has done a study to find the impact of this on education system;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has framed any guidelines and regulations for functioning of coaching and tuition centres in the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

**(a) to (e):** Yes, Madam. There are many complaints of increasing presence of coaching centres, although there are no accurate estimates of the business turnover of the coaching institutions. The Government does not consider this as a healthy trend and is committed to strengthen the school education system. Efforts are being made to make the education system and the entrance examinations related more on the class syllabus so as to reduce dependence of students on such coaching.
