- (a) & (b):** Review of FDI policy is an ongoing process and significant changes are made in the FDI policy regime, from time to time, to ensure that India remains an attractive investment destination. Changes are made in the policy after having intensive consultations with stakeholders including concerned Ministries/ Departments, State Governments, apex industry chambers and other organizations after taking approval of the competent authority.

With a view to provide benefits to farmers, give impetus to food processing industries and create employment opportunities, the Finance Minister, in Budget Speech on 29.2.2016, has announced that 100% FDI will be allowed through FIPB route in marketing of food products produced and manufactured in India.
