Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the National Security Guard (NSG) is facing shortage of vital equipment like Night Vision and is ill-equipped to operate at Night as was evident during the Pathankot Air Base sieze by some terrorists;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for not supplying essential equipment to the NSG;

(c) the total funds granted/released/utilized by NSG separately along with the reasons for non-utilization of funds during the last three years; and

(d) the steps taken by the Government to ensure that the NSG is fully equipped to meet any possible eventuality in future?

Financial year	Funds granted	Expenditure	Percentage (%)
2012-13	675.72	660.55	97.75
2013-14	701.80	596.78	85.03
2014-15	674.57	659.54	97.77

Average utilization has been above 93.5% over last three years.
