- (a) whether it is a fact that a number of posts are lying vacant in the Sports Authority of India (SAI) and, if so, the total number of vacancies therein;
- (b) the details of applications pending for appointment on compassionate ground; and
- (c) whether cases of 'die-in-harness' are taken on priority to fulfil the vacancies within the SAI and its centers and if so, the details of the action plan of the Government in this regard?
