Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the central agencies have intensified the hunt for the remaining Students of Islamic Movement of India (SIMI) fugitives;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is true that many suspected SIMI fugitives were killed in an encounter at Nalgonda in Telangana recently; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Students Islamic Movement of India (SIMI) is listed in the First Schedule of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) as a terrorist organization and the intelligence/security agencies both at the Central and State level monitor the activities of this organization. Recently,

important absconding cadres of this outfit were arrested by security agencies in Odisha.

(c) & (d): On 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2015, two armed persons, identified as SIMI activists involved in a Jail break in Khandwa were killed in Police action at Nalgonda district in Telangana.
