Environmental Clearance for Power Plant

- (a) whether it is a fact that the power plant constructed/established in Tarkarli, Konkan, Maharashtra beside the sea has not taken environmental clearance;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (c) whether STP is established there and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the arrangement for proper disposal of waste water/fly ash has been made by the said plant; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?
