WORLD HUMAN RIGHTS REPORT

(a) whether the Government is aware of the Amnesty International's State of World Human Rights Report (2015-16) indicating that there has been an increase in religious tension in India, which has manifested itself in incidents of communal violence;

(b) if so, whether the report has stated that Government authorities have failed to prevent the rise in religious tensions between groups;

(c) if so, whether the Government has identified the reasons for the increase in religious tension; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto?
