PAY DEMAND OF CAPF

2977. SHRI P. KUMAR:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) personnel have demanded parity in their pay among other things, with respect to the civilians, apart from OROP in BSF;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the response of the Government thereon;

(c) whether their demands are long pending; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken to fulfil their demands?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): Group 'A' officers of Executive Cadres of CAPFs have been demanding Non Functional Upgradation (NFU) which is applicable to Organized Group 'A' Service Civilian Officers. They have also filed Writ Petitions in Hon'ble Delhi High Court. The Hon'ble Court has given a judgment on 03.09.2015 to grant benefit of NFU as recommended by the 6th Central Pay Commission to these cadres. However, the same has been challenged by filing Special Leave Petition (SLP) before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, which is subjudice.
