Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the United States of America has provided uranium for the civil nuclear power plants in the country and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the details of the countries that provide uranium for civil nuclear power plants in India?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (Dr. JITENDRA SINGH):

- (a) The United States of America had provided uranium to India during early years of operations of the Tarapur Atomic Power Station (TAPS) - 1&2. However, no uranium has been supplied by the United States of America in the recent times for India's civil nuclear power plants.
- (b) At present, Russia, Canada and Kazakhstan supply uranium for civil nuclear power plants in India.
