Import of Coal

308. DR. P.VENUGOPAL:

Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the coal imports will continue to decline this fiscal due to unprecedented increase in output of the coal by Coal India Limited (CIL), if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the coal imports have come down from 136.6 million tonnes in April-November, 2014 to 119.9 million tonnes in 2015, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the CIL's production increased by 8.8 per cent during the April-November period of the current fiscal 2015- 16; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

(a)&(b): As per CCO reports, during April-November 2015, the import of coal was 127.52 Mte as compared to 137.61 Mte in the corresponding period of 2014-15 showing a decline of 7.3%. This slowdown in import is largely due to the fact that coal production by Coal India Ltd. (CIL) registered a growth of 8.8% during April-November, 2015 over the same period in the previous year.

(c)&(d): During April- November, 2015, the production of coal from CIL was 321.37 Mt compared to 295.40 Mt in the same period of the previous year, thereby achieving a growth of 8.8%.
